Immunization Requirements for School Entry  
2009-2010

Immunizations are an important part of keeping children healthy! The Colorado School Entrance and Immunization Law requires all students to provide proof of immunizations to attend school. Please provide your child's immunization record **before** the first day your child will attend school.

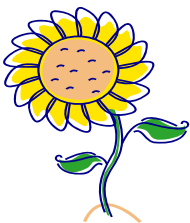
1. **DTaP/DTP**
  - 5 doses (4 doses if last dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
2. **Polio**
  - 4 doses (3 doses if last dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
3. **MMR**
  - 2 doses
4. **Hepatitis B**
  - 3 doses
5. **Varicella**
  - 2 doses
  - OR**
  - History of disease (chickenpox) confirmed and documented by a Health Provider.

Contact your student's health provider with questions regarding immunizations including exemptions from immunizations. Parents may sign the immunization exemption based upon religious or personal beliefs.
